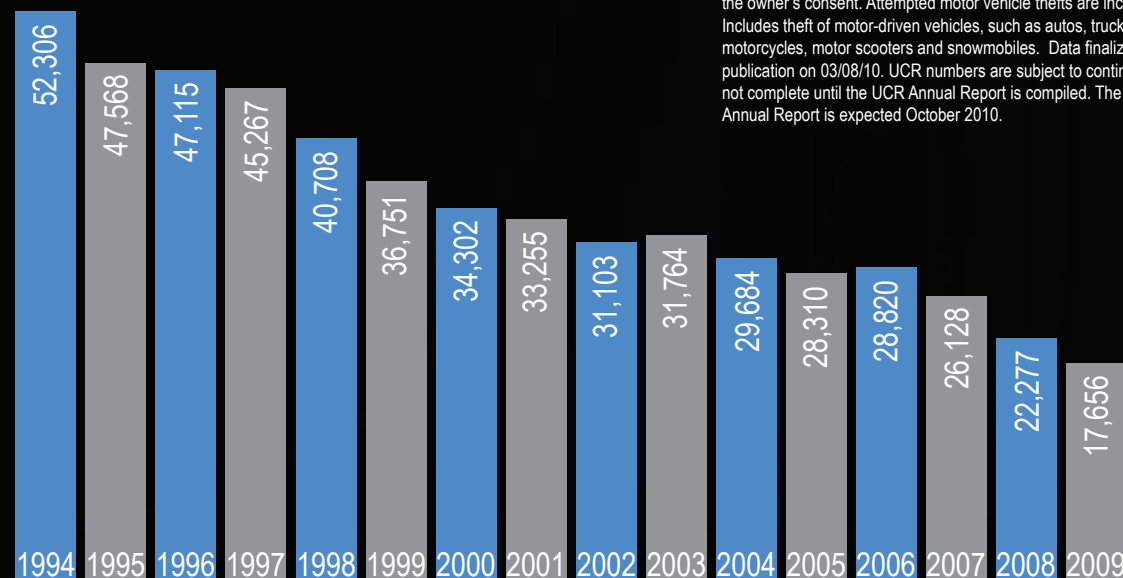

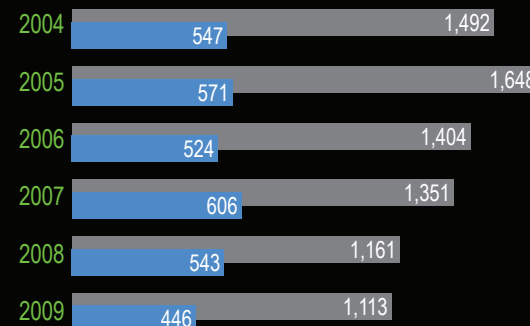


MOTOR VEHICLE THEFTS IN PENNSYLVANIA*
